HISTORY OF PRAVASI BHARATHIYA DAY CELEBRATIONS IN KERALA (From 2003 to 2024)



9th January was declared as “Pravasi Bharathiya Diwas” by the Vajpayee Government in 2002, to Honour Non-Resident Indians residing all over the world for their outstanding contribution for the welfare of our society. In 1915 Mohandas Karam Chand Gandhi returned to India from South Africa on 9th January after his studies and barrister job. Later he took leadership of the independence struggle in India and we got freedom from the British through a peaceful war. And this is the 12th years of his return from South Africa. He became Mahatma Gandhi and was declared “Father of The Nation” by Govt. of India. In remembrance to his return to India, 9th January was declared as **“Pravasi Bharathiya Diwas”**.

Every year on this day prominent NRIs are honoured with Pravasi Bharathiya Samman Awards by the President of India, in the colorful function held in various cities like in India. In Kerala also Pravasi Bharathi Day Celebrations are held every year since 2003 to honour prominent Keralite NRIs and other political and social leaders. The celebrations in Kerala are organized under the auspices of Pravasi Bharathi News Bulletin, the first Non-Resident Magazine Published from Trivandrum and NRI Co-Ordination Council, Kerala since last twenty years. NRI Co-Ordination Council are NRI organizations which look after the problems of Keralite NRIs working abroad. A regional committee comprising of local social and Political Leaders is also formed to organize the celebrations.

All Kerala Gulf Returnees’ Organisation (AKGRO) was formed 36 years back under the leadership of Pravasibandhu Dr. S.Ahamed, who was the founder President and he has led several agitations against the state as well as central governments demanding rehabilitation of poor gulf returnees, pension for them and for several schemes for self employment. AKGRO is one among the 36 NRI organizations registered under Kerala State NRIs and Gulf Returnees’ Co-ordination Council (NRI COUNCIL OF INDIA).





We also do several charity activities during the Pravasi Bharathiya Day Celebration. We have already distributed more than 400 sewing machines to poor gulf returnees for self employment. We have distributed financial assistance to ailing gulf returnees and to poor students for their educational purpose.

Sri.Pranab Kumar Mukherjee and Smt.Pratibha Devisingh Patel, during their tenure as Presidents of India, Union Ministers, Chief Ministers of Kerala and Political Leaders along with leaders from different NRI organizations all over the world appreciated Pravasi Bharathi Day celebrations in Kerala and encouraged us for continuing the functions every year.

Some of the youth with little education and technical knowledge from our state migrated to USA and Middle East and they have excelled in their fields and became successful entrepreneurs, who can be good models for the unemployed, educated youth of Kerala. Such hardworking people became millionaires in a short span of around Sixty decades or less. Non Resident Keralites have played an important role in the over all development of our state, especially in the infrastructure, health and education sectors. During the last Pravasi Bharathiya Day Celebrations in the previous years, we have encouraged such individuals with Pravasi Bharathiya Awards. They are little known in our society. Our Celebrations have brought out their stories of hard work and achievements to the public. In 2007 former state minister and RSP State General Secretary Sri.K.Pankajakshan was honoured with Award. In 2008 former union Minister Sri. O. Rajagopal and in 2009 G.Karthikeyan (former minister) received Pravasi Bharathi Awards from us. In 2010 the Award was given to the then Leader of opposition Sri.Oommen Chandy and in 2011 the recipient for the Pravasi Bharathi Award for politicians was given to then Chief Minister of Kerala Sri.V.S.Achuthanandan. In 2012 the political award was given to Sri.K.Muraleedharan MLA, former KPCC President and in 2013 Sri.G.Sudhakaran MLA.

In 2003, 2004 and 2005 the Celebrations were held in Trivandrum. In 2003, former Chief Secretary Dr. Babu Paul IAS and Seniormost freedom fighter and well known Gandhian Sri. Jubba Ramakrishna Pillai inaugurated the function and distributed awards. In 2004, former Minister of State for Defence Sri. O. Rajagopal inaugurated the function and distributed awards. In 2005, former UN Ambassador Sri. T. P. Sreenivasan inaugurated the celebrations and distributed the awards. In 2006 the Pravasi Bharathi Celebrations were held in Ernakulam and Dr. Sebastian Paul M.P. inaugurated the function and distributed awards. In 2007 the Celebrations were held





in Kannur and State Civil Supplies Minister Sri. C. Divakaran and Freedom Fighter Sri K. E. Mammen were the Chief guests who inaugurated the function and distributed awards. In 2008, the sixth Pravasi Bharathi Day Celebrations were held in Kozhikode and Union Minister of State for Law and Justice Sri K. Venkatapathy inaugurated the function and distributed awards for NRIs and other dignitaries. In 2009 Sri.Uthradaom Thirunal Marthanda Varma, in 2010 former minister Sri.C.Divakaran, in 2011 former Minister N.K.Premahandran, in 2012 Minister Sri.A.P. Anilkumar and in 2013 Deputy Speaker Sri.N.Sakthan inaugurated the PBD Celebrations in Trivandrum. In 2014 , 12th Pravasi Bharathi Day celebrations were organized in Trivandrum from 9th to 11 January, 2014 which was inaugurated by Hon.Speaker Sri.G.Karthikeyan.
